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MEATCO OPERATIONS IN KAZA - TFC

- MEATCO operated Katima Mulilo & Oshakati Abattoirs in Northern Communal Areas of Namibia since 1992.
- Due to cumulative operational losses of over N\$300million from 1992 – 2014, Meatco pulled out of NCA abattoirs.
- In 2014 Namibia lost South African market, due that market refusing beef FMD vaccinated cattle.



Mobile Slaughter Unit



- Was introduced in 2016 to take abattoir closer to farmers.
- Lower operational costs in that the unit is switched off when there is no slaughter.
- Due to high cost of new site establishment the MSU have not relocated since it was introduced.
- Lack of meat maturation hence limited market access.

Meatco NCA Operations – Operational guideline in KAZA - TFC

Meatco NCA Operations is premised on Commodity Based Trade (CBT).

Circular v 7 /2019: CBT Protocol for the marketing of beef from the FMD Protection and Infected zones of Namibia.

CBT - Are Standards, Procedures and Guidelines to facilitate safe trade in meat and meat products and movement of meat and meat products from the FMD infected and Protection zone in the Northern Communal Areas of Namibia (NCA) to Free zone or export markets.

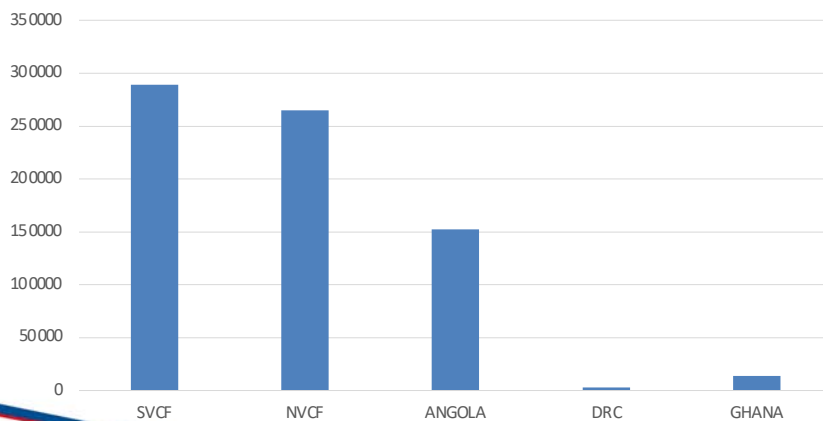

MARKETING

- Zambezi region is a net beef producer with very small market & buying power.
- High interest in offals and low value beef products.
- CBT makes it possible to move high value beef (deboned beef) produced from Katima Mulilo abattoir to access outside markets including FMD free zone.

2. Eartags & 90 day residence



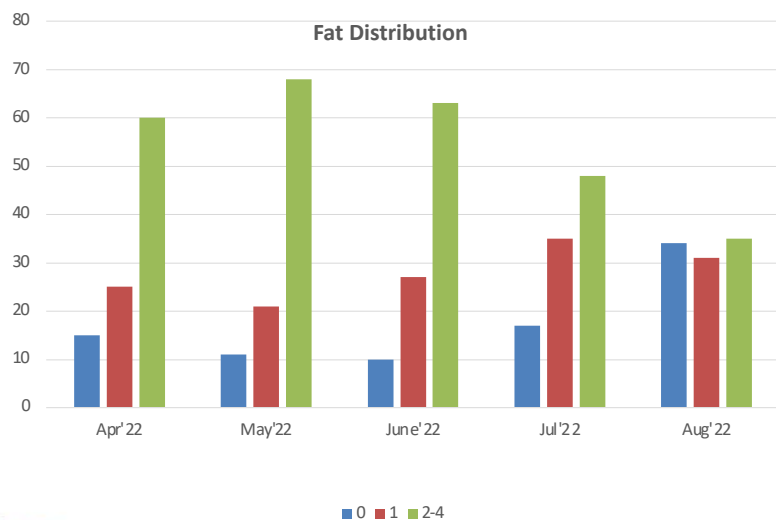
3. Lack of trucks & loading facilities
